Pursuant to §943.059, Florida Statutes and FRCrP 3.692

- 1. The petitioner has never been previously adjudicated guilty of a criminal offense or a comparable ordinance violation nor adjudicated delinquent for committing a felony or a misdemeanor specified in §943.051(3)(b), Florida Statutes.

ORDERED AND ADJUGED that the clerk of this court shall forward a certified copy of this order to (check one) ____ state attorney, _____ special prosecutor, _____ statewide prosecutor, _____ (arresting agency), and the Sheriff of Sarasota County, who will comply with the procedures set forth in §943.059, Florida Statutes, and appropriate regulations of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, and who will further forward a copy of this order to any agency that their records reflect has received the instant criminal history record information; and it is further

ORDERED AND ADJUGED that _____(arresting agency) shall seal all information concerning indicia of arrest or criminal history record information regarding the arrest or alleged criminal activity to which this petition pertains in accordance with the procedures set forth in §943.059, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.692.
